



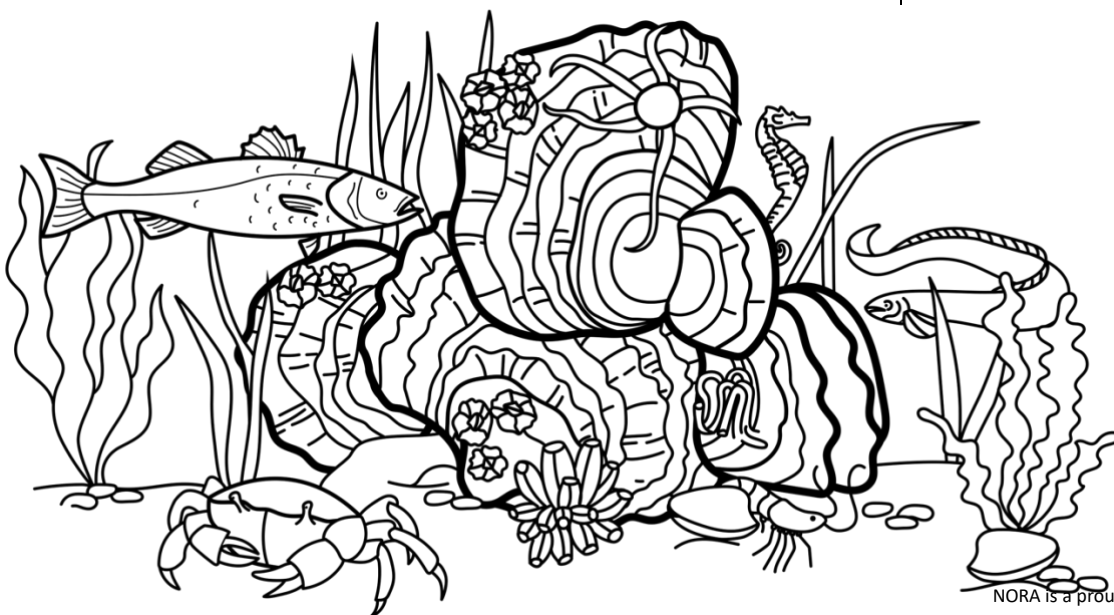
OYSTER HABITAT
